

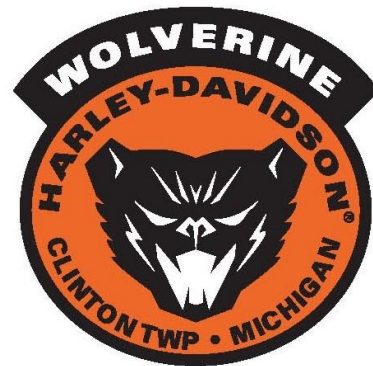

Police	Police motor officers* police motor instructors and reserve/part time officers if their duty assignment is the motor unit with their department; must ride 2009 or newer
Sport	Police motor officers as described above but are assigned a sport motor for duties
Retired	Motor Officers who are retired with full benefits or will be prior to competition
Expert	Civilian and police, non-motor officers and motorcycle instructors
Expert Senior	Civilian and police, non-motor officers who are or will be over the age of 55
Vintage	Civilian and police riding a 2008 HD or older but cannot win overall
Novice	Civilian and police, non-motor officers depending on skill level
