From Jerry Parins.....


Attached is a copy of the poster for this year's ride. They will be printed soon so if you are able to help distribute them, let us know the area.

"Know the State Law" (regarding earplugs)

How's this for a quandary: If we ride without earplugs, we risk permanent damage to our hearing, but in some states riding with earplugs risks breaking the law. According to the American Motorcyclists Association (AMA), the majority states have no restrictions on earplugs. However, several states do have hearing-impairment laws, which make earplugs illegal, or cast them into the murky waters of lawful interpretation. For instance in CA or Ohio you can't use earplugs in both ears, and in Maryland you can only wear custom-molded earplugs. The safest thing to do is to check before you travel. 
